WHAT IS THE FAMILIES FIRST OF MICHIGAN PROGRAM?

Families First of Michigan program is an intensive home-based program, assisting families in crisis. Intensive services are provided for a period of 4-6 weeks. Families First of Michigan counselors spend an average of 10 face-to-face hours with families per week. Together, the Families First of Michigan counselor and family develop and address goals aimed to resolve challenges faced by the family. During the intervention the Families First of Michigan counselor is available to families 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in the event of an emergency.

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SERVICES... RIGHTS... WORKING TOGETHER.

- Families First of Michigan services are provided for a period of 4-6 weeks.
- A trained Families First counselor will meet with you in your home, at a time convenient for you.
- The Families First counselor will spend an average of ten hours each week with your family.
- Together with your family, the Families First counselor will try to help you work out your family's challenges.
- During the intervention your Families First counselor will be available to your family 24 hours a day, seven days a week in the event of an emergency. Your Families First counselor's contact number will be given to you for your family's use.
- Families First believes that parents and children should safely remain together as a family unit.
- You are important.
- Families First believes your family can change and grow.
- The Families First counselor will work with you to strengthen your family.
- Progress can happen if we work together.
- The Families First counselor will work with you on the goals you decide are important.
- Families First will make every effort to help you care for your children.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT TO OCCUR DURING THE INTERVENTION?

The Families First of Michigan program is a strength based, solution-focused model. Some examples of issues that can be addressed include but are not limited to budgeting, communication skills, anger management, safety planning, parenting skills, discipline techniques and issues related to domestic violence.
